

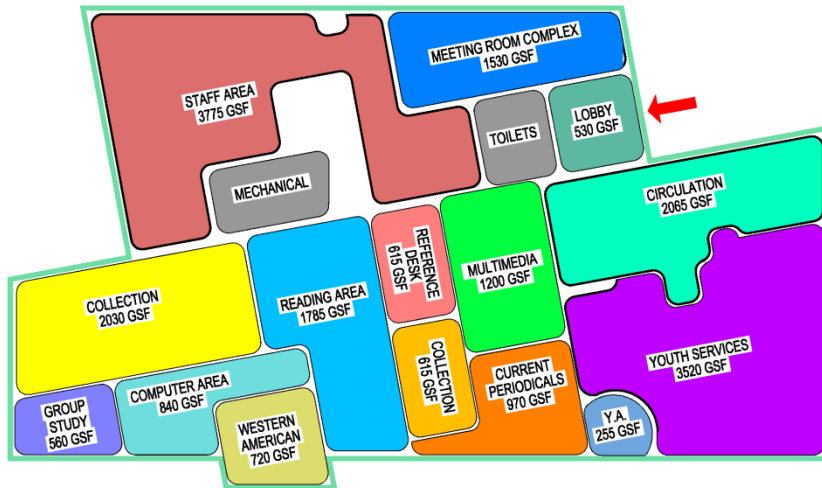

In 2007, ACA completed a Master Facility Plan for Teton County Library. It included a Needs Assessment and Building Program designed to meet the needs of the community for 20 years – to 2027. It was created after in-depth reviews and analyses of documents and statistics relating to the Library and Teton County and its outlying areas, and from information gained during several site visits by our Consulting Team. These visits included interviews, meetings, workshops, and Visual Scans and measurements of Teton County Library buildings.

### OUTCOMES OF MASTER PLAN

- **Assist in the development of a long-range Master Facilities Plan for Library services for Teton County, WY.**  
Assist and enhance flexible meetings and program spaces.  
Assess the library buildings infrastructure, which houses good-sized adult, children's, teens', and reference collections.
- **Provide a plan for Library facilities that meets the needs of the community for 20 years.**  
Part of a multi-faceted strategic planning process carried out by the Library, this report was designed to meet facility needs of the community for the next 20 years.
- **Consider how to maximize existing facilities for the delivery of Library services, programs and collections.**  
The identification of the community's unique and specific Library needs and programming opportunities.  
Staff input and analysis of the Library's current spaces
- **Investigate expansion, remodeling and new facility needs as applicable.**  
Both the Needs Assessment and Building Program documentation promises to satisfy the needs of the Library's customer services, programs and other activities, and the Library's operations to the year 2027.
